

AP World History: Modern

Summer Assignment – from the textbook – Ways.of.the.World;

1. Read and write a three to five paragraph reflection on the Prologue - pages XXXVI – XLII. Formal language (no 1st person, no contractions, etc.) – reflect on major learnings, patterns, etc. – using SPECIFIC examples from the text. This can be typed or written in blue/black ink. Any typed submissions must be ready to be turned in at the beginning of class and not need to be printed.
2. Read and hand-write (ONLY in blue or black pen – typed notes, pencil, other colored pen will NOT be accepted) notes on chapter 1– open notes quiz on day 2 of school.. Be sure to have questions in your notes – what do you not understand? Vocabulary words that you do not understand. What do you want to review? What do you want to know more about?
3. Know general global geography.
4. Know the basics of Islam, Christianity, Buddhism, Hinduism, Confucianism, Daoism, Judaism – create a chart and bring to class.
